4. I affirm that I am the parent or legal guardians of the above-named student and have the requisite authority and right to execute this consent and waiver form without any other person or third party's additional consent or approval.
5. This waiver and consent will remain in effect as long as my child is enrolled in the **SPARKGROUNDS** program(s) or until I notify SPARKGROUNDS LLC in writing that I revoke this authorization.
